###### 1. A \_\_\_\_\_ (2) – *there came a sound*

###### 2. V \_\_\_\_\_ (3) – *there appeared*

“In OT times the regular consequences of a man’s being possessed by the Spirit of God was that he \_\_\_\_\_.” (F. F. Bruce)

The promise of being immersed in the Spirit (Acts 1:5) is fulfilled in Acts 2:3b when the Holy Spirit “\_\_\_\_\_ upon each of them;” also described in Acts 11:15-16 as “\_\_\_\_\_ on them.”

The believer is never commanded to be \_\_\_\_\_ in the Spirit but is commanded to be \_\_\_\_\_ with the Spirit (Eph 5:18).

###### 3. V \_\_\_\_\_ (4) – *began to speak*

The result of these 120 believers being baptized in the Holy Spirit is that they are no longer individual units but \_\_\_\_\_ body (1 Cor 12:13).
