Even the Gentile world knew why Israel went into captivity! (Deuteronomy 29:24-28; 1 Kings 9:7-9; Jeramiah 22:8-9; 40:2-3)

The Greek word for *"forsake"* in Joshua 1:5 is the same Greek word for *"winked"* here. Whereas God was telling Joshua that he would not leave him alone, in Acts 17:30 the idea is that God did f\_\_\_\_\_\_ the heathen; i.e., He left them alone.

The idea of "winked" was expressed in Acts 14:16 and later in Romans 3:25 with a different word, "f\_\_\_\_\_\_."
