**II. DELAY (13-16) – why tarriest thou?**

**A. The P\_\_\_\_\_ of Saul's Commission (17)**

a. Saul's Part in P\_\_\_\_\_cuting Believers (19)

b. Saul's Part in E\_\_\_\_\_cuting Believers (20)

Having been chief persecutor he thought he could now be chief pers\_\_\_\_\_.

His former fellow-persecutors had witnessed his zeal against Christ (22:5); so Saul reasoned that they would see the change in his life and as a result accept his witness \_\_\_\_\_ Christ!
