##### 1. By **O**\_\_\_\_\_ (19)

Paul's response was that he was "*not disobedient*." I.e., he was convinced And this, his first response, became his p\_\_\_\_\_!

##### 2. By **S**\_\_\_\_\_ (20-21)

###### a. **E**\_\_\_\_\_tent (20a)

"*Shewed*" = "kept on announcing" – "to bring to notice something not previously known. Paul began to do so immediately right where \_\_\_\_\_!"

###### b. **C**\_\_\_\_\_tent (20b)

"*Works meet for repentance*" is literally

"w\_\_\_\_\_ -of-the-changed-thinking-works."

##### 3. By **O**\_\_\_\_\_ (21)

True repentance (changed thinking), when opposition arises, does not r\_\_\_\_\_ again (change back)!

Paul's continued witnessing was not without his

"*having obtained h\_\_\_\_\_ from God!*"
